EXPLANATION OF VOTES - SENATE

- 1) S. F. 1 - Raised garnishment of wages from \$250 to \$1,000 per creditor per year. No vote IFL position. Ayes 22 - Nays 24 - Absent 4.
- 2) Senate Amendment S-3091 to S. F. 268, Mandatory Sentencing, would not allow for good time off the sentence. No vote IFL position. Ayes 21 - Nays 27 - Absent 2.
- 3) H. F. 414 - SCHOOL FOUNDATION PLAN, lowered appropriations going to local school districts. No vote IFL position. Ayes 27 - Nays 23.
- 4) Senate Amendment S-3157 to S. F. 284, DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE, would not let the phone companies charge for directory assistance if the number was not in the directory. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 29 - Nays 19 - Absent 2.
- 5) Same as #4 above - was voted on again by a motion to reconsider. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 23 - Nays 26 - Absent 1.
- 6) Senate Amendment S-3276 to S. F. 420, SITING OF HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT, increased the temporary resident members on the board to determine location from one to two members. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 23 - Nays 22 - Absent 5.
- 7) S. F. 414 - PROVIDES FOR THE PURCHASE BY CERTAIN STATE AGENCIES OF MOTOR VEHICLES MANUFACTURED IN THIS COUNTRY. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 34 - Nays 13 - Absent 3.
- 8) S. F. 463 - WORKERS COMPENSATION, raised the exemption for agriculture workers from \$1,000 payroll to \$2,500 and exempted all employers, including partners, and family members from the corporation. No vote IFL position. Ayes 45 - Nays 4 - Absent 1.
- 9) S. F. 570 - PLAN 1, CONGRESSIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 21 - Nays 28 - Absent 1.
- 10) H. F. 771, REGULATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES. No vote IFL position. Ayes 29 - Nays 18 - Absent 2 - Present 1.
- 11) S. F. 580 - PLAN 2, CONGRESSIONAL AND LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 24 - Nays 26.

EXPLANATION OF VOTES - HOUSE

- 1) House Amendment H-3042 to House File 232 (Funding of Social Services specified programs July 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981) reduced eligibility by 4.68 instead of a 108 proposed cut for homemaker, child care and chore services. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 46 - Nays 48 - Absent 6.
- 2) H. F. 414, SCHOOL FOUNDATION PLAN, reduced dollars going to local school districts and added burden to local property taxes. No vote IFL position. Ayes 55 - Nays 45.
- 3) House Amendment H-3072 to House File 303 (Registration of group day care home providers) reduced the physical requirements of homes and centers for day care for children. No vote IFL position. Ayes 37 - Nays 59 - Absent 4.
- 4) House Amendment H-3458 to House File 804 (correcting erroneous provisions of the Code) allowed 65 foot double bottom trucks on certain highways in Iowa. Yes vote IFL position. Ayes 56 - Nays 39 - Absent 5.
- 5) H. F. 771, REGULATION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES. No vote IFL position. Ayes 55 - Nays 43 - Absent 2.
- 6) House Resolution 22, relating to THE AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS' DISPUTE. Motion was made to refer to committee on transportation. No vote IFL position. Ayes 49 - Nays 46 - Absent 5.
