2. Senate Amendment S-3068 to House Amendment S-3062 to Senate Concurrent Resolution 4 removed the prevailing wage language from the resolution. NAY vote IFL position. Ayes 24 - Nays 21 - Absent 5.
3. House Joint Resolution 14, a joint resolution to nullify an administrative rule of the department of employment services relating to lockouts. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 26 - Nays 24.
4. Senate Amendment S-3448 to Senate Amendment S-3447 to Senate File 481 (an Act relating to state tax revenues and expenditures) set a maximum income tax rate at 6 1/2%. NAY vote IFL position. Ayes 20 - Nays 29 - Absent 1.
5. House File 153, an Act relating to the state's conforming its income, franchise, and death taxes with the new federal tax provisions. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 27 - Nays 23.
6. House File 355, an Act relating to and making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year '86 - '87. AYE vote IFL position. ayes 26 - Nays 22 - Absent 2.
7. Senate Amendment S-3761 to Senate File 504 (an Act relating to the compensation and benefits for public officials and employees by specifying salary rates and ranges) kept legislators salaries at the present level. NAY vote IFL position. Ayes 10 - Nays 39 - Absent 1.
8. Senate File 504, an Act relating to the compensation and benefits for public officials and employees by specifying salary rates and ranges. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 29 - Nays 21.
9. Senate Amendment S-3824 to Senate File 511 (an Act relating to and making appropriations to agencies, boards, commissions, departments and programs of state government) removed tuition tax deductions from the bill. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 18 - Nays 32.
10. House File 469, an Act to regulate the circumstance and procedure under which an employer may request a drug test of an employee or an applicant for employment and providing a penalty. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 31 - Nays 16 - Absent 3.
11. House File 500, an Act relating to the state civil rights law and the civil rights commission. AYE vote IFL position. Ayes 33 - Nays 16 - Absent 1.

NAY vote IFL position. Ayes 37 - Nays 58 - Absent 5.
2. House Amendment H-3053 as amended to House File 153 (an Act relating to the state's conforming its income, franchise, and death taxes with the new federal tax provisions by updating references to the Internal Revenue Code) placed the deduction for sales tax and use tax back into the Iowa tax code. NAY vote IFL position. Ayes 37 - Nays 59 - Absent 4.
3.
