### IOWA SENATE - ISSUES - <sup>1991</sup> ~~1990~~

1. Senate Joint Resolution 1 - Puts the Equal Rights Amendment to the Iowa Constitution on the 1992 ballot - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 43-5)
2. Senate File 505 (final passage) - Reforms campaign finance law by placing limits on how much candidates can spend in their campaigns - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 31-17)
3. Amendment S-3190 to Senate File 457 - Prohibits public employee dues checkoff - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 16-31)
4. Senate File 457 (final passage) - Adds discipline and discharge as mandatory subjects of bargaining for public employees - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 35-14)
5. Senate File 457 - Attempt to override Governor's veto of discipline and discharge. (Failed to get two-thirds necessary to override 26-23)
6. Senate File 458 (final passage) - Provides public employee unions the right to bargain for health care benefits for early retirees in physically dangerous jobs - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 29-19)
7. Amendment S-3362 to Senate File 321 - Allows persons indirectly injured by antitrust violations to sue for redress - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 24-23)
8. Vote to confirm Richard Witham as member of Iowa Economic Development Board - NO vote is IFL position. (Confirmation failed to receive necessary two-thirds vote, 24-26)
9. Vote to confirm Robert Wilson as Industrial Commissioner - NO vote is IFL position. (Confirmation failed to receive necessary two-thirds vote, 25-25)
10. House File 517 (final passage) - Raises minimum workers' compensation benefits and death benefits, keeps workers from being sued for workers' compensation medical expenses - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 37-10)
11. Senate File 548 (final passage) - Funds public employee salary arbitration awards - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 39-11)
12. Amendment S-3784 to House File 713 - Limits state government's ability to fund basic services, salaries, pensions - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 22-25)
13. Amendment S-3789 to Amendment S-3785 to House File 713 - Caps Federal deductibility at \$25,000 a year, raising taxes on people making over \$100,000 a year - YES vote is IFL position. (Failed 21-25)

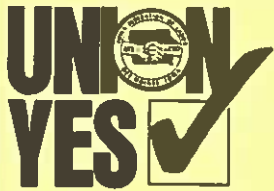

### IOWA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - ISSUES 1991

- 1. Senate Joint Resolution 1 - Puts the Equal Rights Amendment to the Iowa Constitution on the 1992 ballot - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 87-9)
- 2. Amendment H-3220 to House File 479 - Strikes a regressive increase in excise taxes from the budget - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 76-23)
3. Amendment H-3252E to House File 479 - Caps federal deductibility at \$25,000 a year, raising taxes on people making over \$100,000 a year - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 55-43)
- 4. House File 517 (final passage) - Raises minimum workers' compensation benefits and death benefits, keeps workers from being sued for workers' compensation medical expenses - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 78-18)
45. House Joint Resolution 5 (motion to suspend the rules to allow a vote) - Limits state and local government's ability to fund basic services, salaries, pensions - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 43-53)
- 6. Senate File 502 (final passage) - Puts surtax on businesses to adequately fund second injury fund for next year - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 74-18)
7. Senate File 457 (final passage) - Adds discipline and discharge as mandatory subjects of bargaining for public employees - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 52-45)
8. House File 683 (final passage) - Encourages industry to substitute safe chemicals for toxic chemicals in the workplace - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 54-43)
9. Amendment H-3843 to Senate File 529 - Restores funding for minimum wage enforcement and contractor registration - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 55-44)
- 10. Amendment H-3970 to House File 702 - Freezes county spending for mental health services, not only hurting mental health services, but potentially forcing regressive tax hikes at state level - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 46-51)
11. Amendment H-4000 to House File 705 - Exempts agricultural and commercial land from fee increase to fund low and middle income housing programs - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 49-51)
12. House File 705 (final passage) - Puts \$2.1 million into low and middle income housing programs - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 55-45)
- 13. Amendment H-3582 to House Resolution 19 - Urging Congress to adopt national health care - YES vote is IFL position. (Lost on a 45-45 tie vote)
14. House Resolution 22 - Urging Congress to deny fast track authority on GATT and Mexico free trade agreements - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 53-42)
15. Senate File 505 (final passage) - Reforms campaign finance law by placing limits on how much candidates can spend in their campaigns - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 52-46)
16. Senate File 548 (final passage) - Funds public employee salary arbitration awards - YES vote is IFL position. (Adopted 63-33)
17. Amendment H-4130 to House File 713 - Limits state government's ability to fund basic services, salaries, pensions - NO vote is IFL position. (Defeated 47-52)
