## 1992 VOTING RECORD IOWA GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The voting record by no means covers all the issues that the Iowa Federation of Labor, AFL-CIO worked with during the 1992 Legislative session. It does, however, record legislator's votes on a number of key issues of concern to union members and their families, and thus reflects their support or non-support of worker issues.

The voting record does not reflect the negative role that Governor Branstad played in the Legislative process. Once again his vetoes stopped progressive legislation from being enacted. Also, the record does not reflect the Governor's continuing attack on public workers with his refusal (until ordered by the Iowa Supreme Court) to grant state public workers the pay increase that was awarded by the arbitrators.
