EXPLANATION OF VOTES - HOUSE

- House Amendment H-5043 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Imposed a state minimum tax for tax preference equal to twenty-five percent of the state's apportioned share of the federal minimum tax. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 49 - Nays 48 - Absent 3.
- House Amendment H-5081 to House Amendment H-5058 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Set a maximum amount of federal income taxes to be deducted from Iowa income taxes at \$15,000 (\$15,000 Federal Deductibility). YES vote IFL position. Ayes 44 - Nays 54 - Absent 2.
- House Amendment H-5244 to Senate Amendment H-5237 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Added up to a ten percent credit, of the qualified wages paid to new employees, to the employer's state income tax. Employees were new employees added during the 1982 calendar year. Speaker ruled H-5244 not germane and the vote recorded was to suspend the rules to consider H-5244. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 42 - Nays 52 - Absent 6.
- House Amendment H-5252 to Senate Amendment H-5237 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Changed property tax valuation from 30% of acquisition cost to 50%. Set up a 2 million dollar interest subsidy fund for small business. Speaker ruled H-5252 not germane and the vote recorded was to suspend the rules to consider H-5252. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 41 - Nays 55 - Absent 4.
- House Amendment H-5233B to House File 2363 (Establishment of a soil conservation loan program by the Iowa family farm development authority). Made a farmer eligible for lower interest rate for loans for soil conservation if his net worth was less than \$500,000. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 44 - Nays 52 - Absent 3.
- House Amendment H-5662 to House Amendment H-5537 to Senate File 2091 (Increased the rate of excise tax on gasoline). Imposed upon each oil company for the privilege of doing business within this state an annual tax of two percent of its gross receipts apportioned to the state. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 46 - Nays 50 - Absent 4.
- Senate File 2243 - Provides minimum separation distances between new anaerobic lagoons for industrial wastewater treatment and existing residences and providing for rules regarding sulfate content in anaerobic lagoons. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 68 - Nays 31 - Absent 1.
- House Amendment H-5781 to House Amendment H-5667 to Senate File 2218 (Relating to the uses of land in this state). Established in each county a county land preservation and use commission to preserve the availability and productivity of agricultural land, to protect the soil from wind and water erosion, etc. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 49 - Nays 45 - Absent 6.
- House Amendment H-6008 to House Amendment H-5991 to Senate File 2304 (Relating to and making supplemental appropriations July 1, 1982 - June 30, 1983). Made medical assistance available July 1, 1982 through March 31, 1983 to children under twenty-one who meet all eligible criteria of the aid to families with dependent children program. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 46 - Nays 51 - Absent 3.
- House Amendment H-5996 to Senate File 2304 (Relating to and making supplemental appropriations July 1, 1982 - June 30, 1983). Added \$75,000 to community based elderly services. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 46 - Nays 49 - Absent 5.
- House Amendment H-5979 to Senate File 2304 (Relating to and making supplemental appropriations July 1, 1982 - June 30, 1983). Increased appropriation for public transit purposes to implement a state assistance plan from \$1,908,000 to \$2,000,000. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 43 - Nays 53 - Absent 4.

EXPLANATION OF VOTES - SENATE

1. Senate Amendment S-3704 to Senate File 560 (Imposition of local option income surtax, earnings tax or vehicle tax). Increased passage of a referendum vote from a majority to 60% of those voting. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 18 - Nays 26 - Absent 6.
2. Senate Amendment S-3741 to Senate File 560 (Imposition of local option income surtax, earnings tax or vehicle tax). Allowed for the enactment of a local sales tax. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 18 - Nays 30 - Absent 2.
3. Senate File 560 allowed for the imposition of local option income surtax, earnings tax or vehicle tax by a referendum of the voters. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 24 - Nays 25 - Absent 1.
4. Senate Amendment S-5120A to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Allowed an Iowa income tax credit of up to one thousand dollars for each individual recalled, rehired or hired for the taxpayer, trade or business between April 1 and December 31, 1982. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 22 - Nays 27 - Absent 1.
5. Senate Amendment S-5135 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Allowed a property tax credit against the assessed value of property equal to 10% of the increase in the actual wages paid between July 1 and June 30th of the preceding fiscal year. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 24 - Nays 25 - Absent 1.
6. Senate Amendment S-5133 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Allowed an income tax credit to employers when they hire an individual who has been unemployed over six consecutive weeks. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 23 - Nays 26 - Absent 1.
7. Senate Amendment S-5122 to House File 2171 (Updating references to the Internal Revenue Code). Called for a sunset provision of January 1, 1984 for the accelerated depreciation deduction allowance. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 21 - Nays 28 - Absent 1.
8. House File 2171 updated references to the Iowa Internal Revenue Code. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 28 - Nays 22.
9. Senate Amendment S-5305 to Senate File 2243 (Provided minimum separation distances between new anaerobic lagoons for industrial wastewater treatment and existing residences). Struck the new section in the bill that would allow 1250 feet between a residence not owned by a feed lot and the lagoon instead of the present law of 1850 feet. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 18 - Nays 29 - Absent 3.
10. House File 2355 exempted from the workers' compensation law named corporate officers after signing and filing an acceptance of exemption and agricultural employers whose total payroll to nonexempt employees is less than \$2,500 per year. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 34 - Nays 9 - Absent 7.
11. Senate Amendment S-5389A to Senate Amendment S-5353 to Senate File 2273 (Balancing the unemployment trust fund and repaying any loans made by the federal government to Iowa). Imposed a 1% surcharge on taxable wages for employers April 1, 1982 through March 31, 1983. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 12 - Nays 38.
12. Senate Amendment S-5389B to Senate Amendment S-5353 to Senate File 2273 (Balancing the unemployment trust fund and repaying any loans made by the federal government to Iowa). Froze benefits at the July 1, 1981 level through July 2, 1983. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 8 - Nays 40 - Absent 2.
13. Senate Amendment S-5389C to Senate Amendment S-5353 to Senate File 2273 (Balancing the unemployment trust fund and repaying any loans made by the federal government to Iowa). Seasonal employees would not be able to collect unemployment benefits in January, February or March. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 13 - Nays 36 - Absent 1.
14. Senate Amendment S-5544 to Senate File 2300 (Relates to the regulation of financial institutions). Removed the payment of interest on escrow accounts at savings and loan institutions. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 21 - Nays 27 - Absent 2.
15. House File 777, allows a business to assign its collections to a collection agency and take you to small claims court without notice. NO vote IFL position. Ayes 38 - Nays 7 - Absent 5.
16. Senate Amendment S-5592 to Senate File 2304 (Relating to and making supplemental appropriations July 1, 1982 - June 30, 1983). Increased appropriation for public transit purposes to implement a state assistance plan from \$1,908,000 to \$2,000,000. YES vote IFL position. Ayes 23 - Nays 27.
