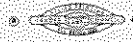
## IOWA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - ISSUES - 1990

1. Amendment H-5798 to Senate File 2249 - Lower the maximum workers' compensation benefit by a third - NO vote is IFL position. (Lost 39-58)
- ~2. Amendment H-5787 to Senate File 2249. Strike sections relating to the payment of permanent partial and permanent total disability payments - NO vote IFL position. (Lost 38-57)
- ~3. S.F. 2249 - Final passage - A bill to expedite the hearing process for contested workers' compensation cases - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 58-33)
- ~4. House File 2009 - Final passage - Election Day registration - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 53-42)
5. House File 156 - Final passage - A bill to split medical premiums off from the rest of workers' compensation in terms of figuring contractor's workers' comp premiums - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 55-42)
6. Senate File 385 - Final passage - Make discipline and discharge mandatory subjects of bargaining for public employees - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 55-43)
- ~7. House File 2201 - Final passage - A bill to mandate the listing of sub-contractors on certain public projects - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 56-40)
- ~8. H.F. 2543 - To concur with conference committee report - A bill to reform IPERS and POR pension system - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 58-40)
9. H.F. 2346 - Final passage - A bill to expand the number of people eligible for unemployment compensation - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 52-44)
10. Amendment H-5991 to H.F. 2554 - An amendment on the property tax relief bill that would have primarily benefited large farm and business owners and cost the state \$30 to \$40 million dollars. NO vote IFL position. (Lost 35-63)
11. Amendment H-5990 to H.F. 2554 - An amendment shifting the cost of mental health services from property taxes to income and sales taxes, benefiting primarily large landowners at the expense of working people. NO vote IFL position. (Lost 44-51)

## IOWA SENATE - ISSUES - 1990

1. S.F. 2249 - Final passage - A bill to expedite the hearing process for contested workers' compensation cases - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 28-20)
2. H.F. 2009 - Final passage- Election Day registration - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 30-19)
3. S.F. 2186 - Final passage - A bill to impose criminal penalties on companies which lie about how many jobs they are going to create and then get state economic development grants. YES vote IFL position. (Passed 30-18)
4. S-5691 - Amendment to H.F. 2346 - An amendment which gutted the proposal to rewrite the unemployment compensation formula to make more unemployed people eligible for benefits - NO vote IFL position. (Lost 26-23)
5. H.F. 2346 - Final passage - A bill to expand the number of people eligible for unemployment compensation - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 29-21)
6. S.F. 2365 - Vote to override Governor's veto - Human Services appropriations bill - YES vote IFL position. (Motion received 29 votes, falling 5 short of 2/3s needed to override)
7. Senate Concurrent Resolution 119 - A resolution condemning the rotation of correctional officers at the Iowa State Penitentiary - YES vote IFL position. (Passed 32-18)
8. Amendment S-5873 to S.F. 2554 - shifts all mental health costs from property taxes to income and sales taxes over 10 years - NO vote IFL position. (Lost 26-21)
9. Amendment S-5853B to H.F. 2546 - Makes the child care tax credit formula less progressive - NO vote IFL position. (Lost 28-18)
