Field Coordinator QRTR 1 2017 Progress Report

Starting off in July, the Field Coordinator began work with the summer community events of the chapters and various community activists. Beginning with the Lee County Labor Chapter Candidate Academy, which brought over twenty activists to begin thinking about their campaigns for local office, as well as developing a field program to work around school board and municipal elections. The Dubuque Federation of Labor organizes union members and volunteers to help with the annual fair as well as the Clinton Labor Congress helped the democrats participate in the Democrats at the Diamond event, which was organized as a follow-up to the Quad City Federation of Labor handbill at the baseball diamond.

The Field Coordinator began to work heavily with the Iowa Federation of Labor's WIN Committee which is a committee designed to engage active and retired union members, community leaders and allies, as well as individual activists. These were formed in a way to engage participation outside labor and is designed to recruit and train candidates for higher office as well as to fight the political battles for working families.

The Great River Area Labor Federation organized a Saturday Retreat with the Iowa Federation of Labor and University of Iowa Labor Center that was urging all executive board members of the great river and succeeding chapters to participate in a strategic planning session to help us prepare for 2018. There were twenty participants and the immediate attention requires forming a Financial Committee as well as a Staff Committee to help place our ideas down on paper.

In the immediate future, our field coordinator will base her work primarily on the city council elections coming up in November, as well as focusing the great river to complete the necessary steps to have our year-end annual report completed on time, so we can operate for fiscal year 2018.
