The Field Coordinator helped with the Special House District Election in Iowa for the first part of the year. She routinely collected Absentee Ballot requests, helped canvass, helped with volunteers and completed the tasks so we were able to win that district by 3:1.

Julia began attending the regular chapter meetings and began to build relationships with the leaders of the organization. We're getting information gathered from the five chapters on affiliated unions and locals, so we can begin to reach-out and introduce the new organization in hopes to have full delegate representation at the chapter meetings, or to at least bring in new affiliates down the road.

The Great River had their elections for executive board, and so she's been helping prepare the filing report for the 2017 deadline by May.

There were two Labor Center courses in the Great River ALF jurisdiction and she was able to recruit just under 30 people for both, which was a great start in recruiting candidates to run for local office in Burlington, or getting folks to attend a workshop on learning about the bills being passed in the Iowa Legislature.

Workers' Memorial Day events have begun to take place and so she's been helping recruit attendance in the chapters that need a little more help than others.
